- Those entering the Scarecrow Trail will be entered on a map (Street name only) and these maps will be handed out to the public on request, to follow a trail and to judge their first, second and third favourite.
- Scarecrows will be judged by the public are for display purposes only and will remain the property of those who make the scarecrow.
- You will be responsible for the removal or any materials used in your display.
- In the event of a tie, Lindfield in Bloom will select a winner.
- The judge's decision is final.
- Trail maps with voting forms will be available from the Lindfield Arts Festival Information Point throughout the day.
- Judging will take place throughout the day and the Scarecrow with the most votes will be announced as the winner at 5pm at the LAF information Point.
